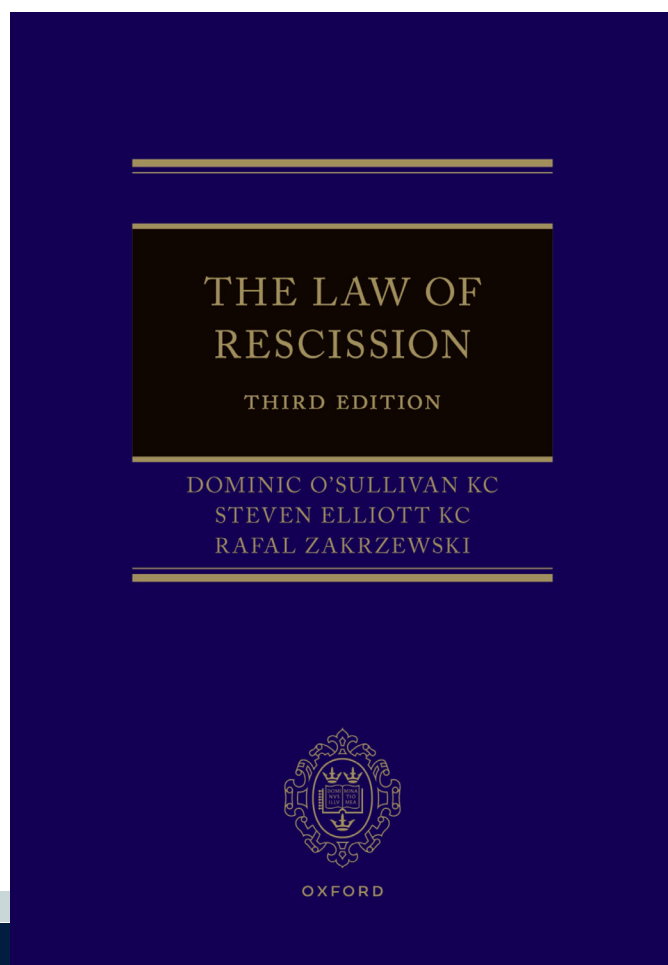


# The Law of Rescission
