D. STEVENSON – GINGER BEER

POSSIBLE SNAIL CONTAMINATION

DO NOT CONSUME THIS PRODUCT



PRODUCT DETAILS

Product: D. Stevenson Ginger Beer

Manufacturer: D. Stevenson, Glen Lane, Paisley

Pack: Opaque glass bottle

Affected batches: Batch identification unavailable – all potentially affected stock should be withdrawn

Recall level: Consumer recall

WHY IS THIS PRODUCT BEING RECALLED?

D. Stevenson is recalling ginger beer because some bottles may contain foreign biological material, including decomposed gastropods.

Because the product is supplied in an opaque glass bottle, contamination cannot reasonably be detected by the consumer before consumption.

HEALTH RISK

Consumption of an affected product may cause severe gastroenteritis, including nausea, vomiting and acute abdominal pain.

Discovery of decomposed foreign biological material after partial consumption may also cause shock.

Medical treatment may be required.

ACTION FOR RETAILERS

- Remove affected stock from sale immediately.
- Quarantine all remaining bottles.
- Do not rely on visual inspection of unopened bottles.
- Display this recall notice prominently.
- Record quantities sold, returned or destroyed.

WHAT SHOULD CONSUMERS DO?

Do not drink the product. If you have an affected bottle, return it to the place where it was purchased for a full refund.

Proof of purchase is not required. This recall applies whether you purchased the product yourself or it was purchased for you by another person.

WHO IS AFFECTED?

Anyone who has purchased or consumed D. Stevenson Ginger Beer from the affected production run. This includes persons so closely and directly affected by the product that the manufacturer ought reasonably to have them in contemplation.
